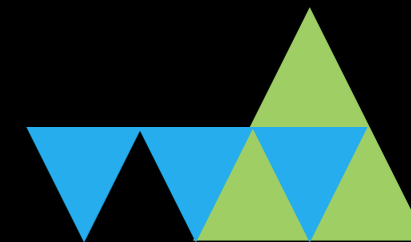

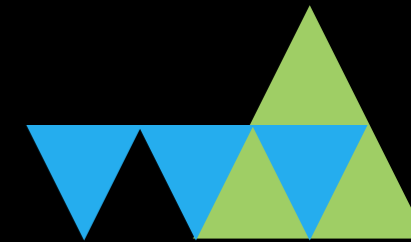

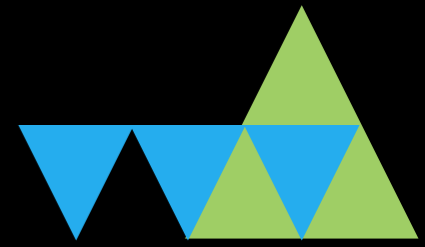

1. Lived as a sacrifice

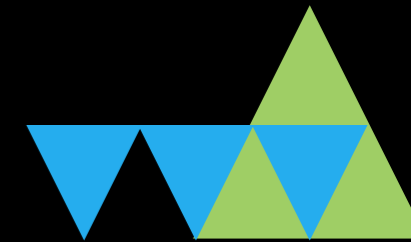

ORIGIN 1600s: Latin *missiōn-* (stem of *missiō*) a sending off

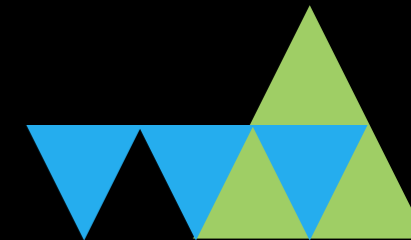

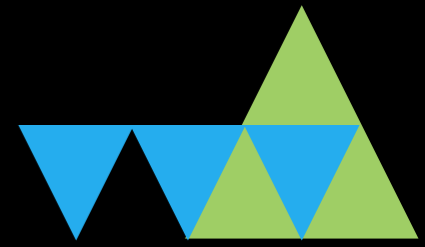
